Esther 1:1-2

INTRODUCTION

A. We are God's Masterpieces. (Ephesians 2:10)

"Men go abroad to wonder at the height of mountains, at the waves of the sea, at the long courses of rivers, at the vast compass of the season, at the circular motion of the stars; and they pass by themselves without wondering."

- 1. We were **created** in Christ Jesus.
- 2. We were created "for good works."
- 3. We were created for the good works which He **prepared beforehand**.
- B. We are sculpted by the Potter. (Isaiah 64:8b)
 - 1. We are **uniquely** formed.
 - 2. We are a part of His divine destiny.
 - 3. With God, ordinary people become extraordinary.

b. The will of God.

d. The presence of God.
